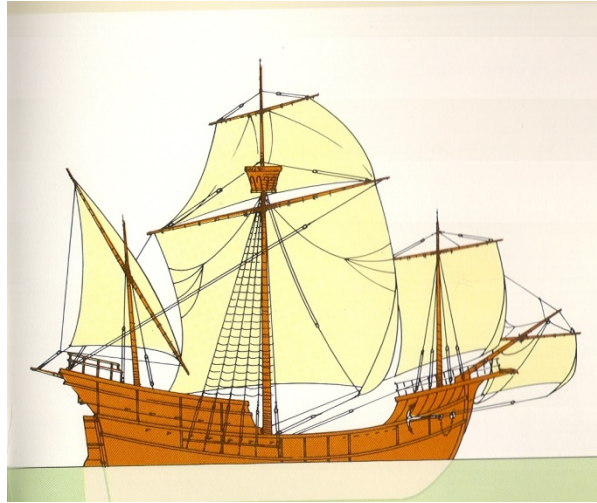


## Call for Presenters

### “Navigation, Travel, and Exploration in World History”

NERWHA is pleased to announce that its Fall 2016 Symposium will convene on Saturday, 24 September, at Salem Academy, home of “The Navigators.” In homage to its host institution and to the port city of Salem, the symposium organizers welcome proposals for panels, round tables, workshops, single papers, and posters on any aspect of research or pedagogy relating to navigation, travel, or exploration in the context of world history from antiquity to the recent past.

Persons who wish to be considered for inclusion in the program should submit, in a **single MS Word file**, an abstract of no more than 300 words and a one-page CV **before 1 August 2016**. Where a complete panel is proposed, the convener should include a 250-word abstract of the panel’s theme. Each panelist should plan to spend no more than 20 minutes presenting her or his paper.
